

# RESTRAINING ORDERS IN SACRAMENTO COUNTY

## EMERGENCY PROTECTIVE ORDER

Protects victims of abuse, serious harassment, or stalking. An emergency protective order is available from law enforcement when they are on-scene and granted by the court. These orders are only valid for 7 calendar days so individuals must apply for another type of restraining order applicable to their circumstances.

## DOMESTIC VIOLENCE RESTRAINING ORDER

Protects individuals from a spouse or former spouse; person you are dating, or a person you have dated; lover; another parent of your child; anyone closely related to you by blood, marriage, or adoption; or person who regularly lives in your home.

## CIVIL HARASSMENT RESTRAINING ORDER

Protects individuals from someone you have not dated and do not have a close relationship with like a neighbor, a roommate, friend, or family member not listed under Domestic Violence Restraining Orders.

**ALL RESTRAINING ORDERS MUST BE SERVED TO THE RESTRAINED PARTY BEFORE THEY CAN BE HELD ACCOUNTABLE FOR VIOLATING THE COURT ORDER.**
