TOY AND MEAL REFERRALS

Salvation Army

WHAT: Christmas Toys

WHERE: 4350 Raley Blvd. Suite 200, Sacramento, CA 95838 (cross street is Bell Ave.)

WHEN: October 18, 2012 – November 19, 2012, 9:00 am – 3:00 pm, Tuesday – Saturday (closed for Thanksgiving) **HOW:** Apply in person at 4350 Raley Blvd., Suite 200. No children allowed in the building or interview area. Must bring all of the following: government ID for everyone in the household, current proof of residence (utility bill or rental agreement, <u>not</u> cell phone bill), proof of income for all adults, social security cards for all residents, as well as birth certificates for all children in the family. Children must be age 10 and under. The program will accept 100 people per day on a first come, first served basis.

Toys for Tots

WHAT: Christmas Toys WHEN: Requests can be made from October 1, 2012 – December 3, 2012 HOW: Must register online at <u>www.toysfortots.org</u> (only way to apply)

WHAT: Adopt-A-Family

WHERE: 1300 Ethan Way, Suite 600, Sacramento, CA 95825 (916.567.3100)

WHEN: Applications can be picked up and turned in November 1 – December 1, Monday – Friday, 10:00 am – 3:00 pm **HOW:** Applications cannot be completed over the phone or online. To complete your application, you must provide your own copes of the following: valid California driver license or ID for parent/guardian, proof of income (including everything you receive: paycheck stubs, CalWorks, AFC, EDD, SSI), current utility bill or proof of where you reside, birth certificate or social security card for each child, letter from parent/guardian explaining why your family needs to be adopted (please include information about your current living situation and employment as well as struggles), Dear Santa letters (one from each child; if child is too young, have them draw something instead), and pictures of your children are encouraged but not mandatory. Copies cannot be made at the Volunteer Center, so bring copies with you.

Stanford Settlement Neighborhood Center

WHAT: Christmas Baskets (food, voucher for grocery store, 1 toy for each child under 15 listed on application) WHERE: 450 West El Camino Avenue, Sacramento, CA 95833

Serving only these zip codes: 95815, 95833, 95834, 95835, 95838

WHEN: Beginning November 1, 2012, 9:00 am – 12:00 pm; not available the week of Thanksgiving **HOW:** One adult from the household must apply in person at 450 W. El Camino Avenue. Applicant needs to bring his or her own photo ID, 2 current items for each adult 18 and over in household with their name and address (i.e. rent

receipt, utility bill, letters with legible postmark), 1 current item from October, November <u>and</u> December 2012 with name and address (i.e. copy of school registration form, letter from doctor, school, etc.) for each child in the household. Limit one basket per address. Cannot apply for services if receiving services elsewhere in Sacramento. More information at 916.927.1303.

WHAT: Christmas Food Baskets

WHEN: Sign-ups begin November 26, 2012 and end December 14, 2012; 10:00 am – 1:30 pm, Monday through Friday **HOW:** Recipient must bring identification (driver license) and a utility bill from within the last 3 months; must live in one of the listed zip codes to be eligible. Distribution of baskets will happen at a later date (TBD, but around 12/20/12).

WHAT: Food Program (general, not holiday specific)

HOW: Please bring proof of address, photo identification and a cart with you.
