## **EXPLOITATION?**

- 1. Having sex for money or to meet your basic needs.
- 2. Someone else is forcing or pressuring you to have sex with other people. This person could be someone you love and trust, like a family member, friend, or partner.

### **WARNING SIGNS OF EXPLOITATION:**

- Being asked/forced to communicate on separate phones
- Feeling or being told you must repay a debt by having sex for money
- Being asked/forced to have a specific tattoo that you would not choose/want
- Pressure to keep the relationship a secret
- Monitored movement/ communication
- Demanding sexually explicit photos or videos

- Gifts with the expectation of something in return
- Promises of money or things of value
- Not having control over your money
- Creating dependence to meet basic needs
- Blackmail or threats
- Pressure to have sex with other people
- Controlling relationships
- Physical and sexual harm or the threat of it
