WEAVE knows that responsibility for sexual assault lies solely with the perpetrator.

We demand accountability of perpetrators.

We will not tolerate victim blaming.

WEAVE is working every day to change the way our community responds to sexual assault.

You can be part of the conversation to create a community that does not tolerate sexual assault by being aware and speaking up when you see dangerous behavior.

Just like it is never your fault if your home is robbed, sexual assault is never the fault of the victim. Awareness can help identify potential assailants and enable others to intervene to stop an assault.

90% of sexual assault victims know the perpetrator.

50% of sexual assaults involve alcohol use by the assailant, victim, or both

6-10% of college aged men admit to sexually assaulting a peer.

2/3's of these men are serial rapists.

When celebrating the holidays, go with friends and have a designated driver.

Communicate – let others know if you are seeing "red flags".

Red Flags:

- Someone encouraging you or a friend to drink excessively.
- Someone trying to isolate a friend or leave with them.
- Someone showing too much interest in an intoxicated friend.
 - Someone buying you drinks or trying to handle your drink.

Trust your instincts. Intervene if you see someone at risk. Ask for help.
